3 C. A filled prescription label shall include the name and  
4 address of the pharmacy of origin, date of filling, name of  
5 patient, name of prescriber, directions for administration, and  
6 prescription number. The symptom or purpose for which the drug is  
7 being prescribed may appear on the label, if provided by the  
8 practitioner and the patient or the patient's authorized  
9 representative so requests. If the symptom or purpose for which a  
10 drug is being prescribed is not provided by the practitioner, the  
11 pharmacist may fill the prescription order without contacting the  
12 practitioner, patient, or the patient's representative. The label  
13 shall also include the trade or generic name, and the quantity and  
14 strength of the drug therein contained, except when otherwise  
15 directed by the prescriber. This requirement shall not apply to  
16 prescriptions or medicines and drugs supplied or delivered  
17 directly to patients for consumption on the premises while  
18 admitted to any hospital or mental institution.

19 D. No prescription shall be written in any characters,  
20 figures or ciphers other than in the English or Latin language,  
21 generally in use among medical and pharmaceutical practitioners.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.

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
