3 AS INTRODUCED

4 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
5 amending Section 1, Chapter 74, O.S.L. 2009, as
6 amended by Section 1, Chapter 247, O.S.L. 2010 (59
7 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 367.8), which relates to the
8 maintaining of emergency medication kits in certain
9 facilities; modifying pharmacies that may maintain
10 certain substances in emergency medication kits;
11 deleting certain definition; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 74, O.S.L.
15 2009, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 247, O.S.L. 2010 (59 O.S.
16 Supp. 2010, Section 367.8), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 367.8 A. A [~~long term care~~] pharmacy may maintain
18 controlled dangerous substances in an emergency medication kit
19 used at a facility. The controlled dangerous substances may be
20 used only for the emergency medication needs of a resident at the
21 facility. A [~~long term care~~] pharmacy may maintain drugs in an
22 emergency medication kit for any facility.

23 B. The State Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate rules
24 relating to emergency medication kits, including, but not limited

1 to:

2 1. The amount and type of controlled dangerous substances
3 that may be maintained in an emergency medication kit;

4 2. Procedures regarding the use of drugs from an emergency
5 medication kit;

6 3. Recordkeeping requirements; and

7 4. Security requirements.

8 C. As used in this section[+]

9 ~~[1. "Facility"],~~ "facility" means a facility as defined
10 by the Nursing Home Care Act or an assisted living center as
11 defined by the Continuum of Care and Assisted Living Act[; ~~and]~~

12 ~~[2. "Long term care pharmacy" means a licensed pharmacy~~
13 ~~which primarily provides pharmacy services to a facility].~~

14 [SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1,
15 2011.
