To Oklahoma Medical Providers:

The Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) is asking for your assistance in identifying clinics or facilities interested in providing novel H1N1 vaccine. Clinics or facilities may pre-register at the following link: <http://osiis.health.ok.gov>.

Pre-registration, however, will help the state and communities be better prepared by identifying vaccination venues as well as the potential number of clients to be served.

Categories of Health Alert messages:

**Health Alert** highest level of notification that the Oklahoma State Department of Health will send out. This usually refers to an immediate threat to the OSDH community and requires immediate action.

**Health Advisory** advises medical providers of a condition in the area. These are usually not medical emergencies. These may not require immediate action.

**Health Update** provides updates on previous alerts or advisories. These are unlikely to require immediate action.
