

Did You Know?

Oklahoma Pharmacists Helping Pharmacists (OPHP) is a program that encourages pharmacists needing assistance in dealing with chemical dependencies or other impairments to self-report and maintain their anonymity. Self-referred participants remain “confidential”, “unknown”, and “anonymous” to the profession and the Oklahoma State Board of Pharmacy (OSBP) as long as they adhere to their OPHP contract. OPHP also assists those who are referred by the OSBP. OPHP is an independent professional service organization operating under the umbrella of the Oklahoma Pharmacists Association. Members of OPHP consist of pharmacist volunteers, from many areas of practice, with a desire to their colleagues. Professional literature reveals that pharmacists have a similar rate of addiction as the general public. Statistics indicate that 12-15 percent of all pharmacists in Oklahoma qualify as impaired.
