Drug-Testing Features and Benefits for OPHA Members

Pre-ordering tests – allows members to pre-order drug tests online, saving considerable time.

Monitor test status – such as "donor checked-in," "in-process," "refused" or "completed" along with the test results for at-a-glance convenience.

Each participating member will be set-up as part of PPW's TPA services - there is nothing to install – members only need a computer, Internet connection and laser printer. Members will also have the option of e-mailing the donor authorization form.

Improved donor experience – more efficient process means faster processing by reducing the possibility of omissions.

Faster – pre-populated data, bar code scanners and step-by-step walkthroughs are just a few of the features that speed up the collection process.

Greater accuracy – system checks facilitate greater accuracy during the collection process including digital transfer of data and universal forms with forensic links (unique linking of the laboratory and donor portions of the form as well as the specimen seals).
